Subsequent to the reading of a statement of compliance with the notice requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act and identification of items discussed during closed session, the Commission considered and took formal action on the following matters:

- 1. By vote of 3-0, ratified the minutes of April 8, 2015 public meeting (transcript pages 6-7).
- 2. By a vote of 3-0, granted the resubmitted applications of Mary R. Kramer and Steven A. Pacentrilli for casino key employee licenses (Exhibit EL-2* transcript page 7-8).
- 3. Considered the applications for casino key employee licenses and for qualification and issued the following rulings:

By a vote of 3-0, granted the initial casino key employee license application of Angela Caprio and for qualification as Vice President of Player Development for DGMB Casino, LLC (ruling number 15-05-07-03-A; transcript page 8-9); and

By a vote of 3-0, granted the initial casino key employee license application of Kenneth J. Janssen and for qualification as Vice President & Assistant General Manager for Bally's Park Place, Inc., and Boardwalk Regency Corporation (ruling number 15-05-07-03-B; transcript page 9-12).

- 4. Temporary casino key employee licenses were issued between April 6, 2015 and May 5, 2015, pursuant to Delegation of Authority Resolution Number 13-01-10-16-C to the following applicants: Kenneth W. Adams, III and Daisy Nieves-Robles (Exhibit EL-4*; transcript page 12-13).
- 5. By a vote of 3-0, granted the requested relief and inactivated the casino key employee license held by Christina C. Belluscio (Ruling numbers 15-05-07-05-A; transcript pages 13-14).
- 6. By a vote of 3-0, approved the termination of the casino key employee licenses held by Maureen C. Adams, Dipti Amin, Raymond N. Baals, Jr., Irene N. Seda and Maureen C. Sment (Ruling numbers 15-05-07-06-A, 15-05-07-06-B, 15-05-07-06-C 15-05-07-06-D, and 15-05-07-06-E; transcript pages 14-16).
- 7. By a vote of 3-0 suspended the credential held by Sueheidi A. Vega (a/k/a Sueheidi A. Nellom) and remanded this matter to a hearing (DKT 15-0005-CK) (ruling numbers 15-05-07-07; transcript pages 16-19).
- 8. By a vote of 3-0, approved the stipulation of settlement between the Division of Gaming Enforcement and Lisa M. Shepeski; and granted the initial application of Ms. Shepeski, for a casino key employee license, subject to compliance with certain financial and reporting conditions as provided for in the stipulation (DKT-15-0003-CK) (Ruling number 15-05-07-08; transcript pages 19-20).
- 9. Considered the joint petition of Harrah's Atlantic City Operating Company, LLC (*d/b/a* Harrah's Resort Atlantic City), Bally's Park Place, Inc. (*d/b/a* Bally's Atlantic City), and Boardwalk Regency Corporation (*d/b/a* Caesars Atlantic City) and issued the following ruling:

By a vote of 3-0, approved the joint petition and granted Christine Boxer a multi casino endorsement, upon her casino key employee license, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-91.1; and found Ms. Boxer qualified to serve as Vice President of National Casino Marketing for Harrah's Atlantic City Operating Company, LLC, Bally's Park Place Inc., and Boardwalk Regency Corporation, in accordance with *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-85.1b; and *N.J.A.C.* 13:69C-2.6 (PRN 1121502) (15-05-07-09; transcript pages 20-23).

In accordance with Resolution No. 14-12-10-03, the next closed session of the Commission shall be held on Wednesday, June 10, 2015 at 10:30 a.m. in the Commission Offices (transcript page 23-24).

There being no members of the public to address the Commission, the meeting adjourned at 10:44 a.m.
