RESOLUTION OF THE NEW JERSEY CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION CONCERNING THE PETITION OF ICAHN ENTERPRISES, L.P. AND TROPICANA ATLANTIC CITY CORP. REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR SUNG HWAN CHO TO PERFORM THE DUTIES AND EXERCISE THE POWERS OF CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF ICAHN ENTERPRISES, L.P. PENDING PLENARY QUALIFICATION (PRN 0831202)

WHEREAS, this matter having been brought before the New Jersey Casino Control Commission (Commission) by the Petition of Icahn Enterprises, L.P. (Icahn Enterprises) and Tropicana Atlantic City Corp. (Trop AC) for approval to have Sung Hwan Cho, prior to his plenary qualification, assume the duties and exercise the powers of Chief Financial Officer for Icahn Enterprises, L.P., a holding company of Trop AC for a nine-month period in accordance with the conditions contained in N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1c and N.J.A.C. 13:69C-2.7(c); and

WHEREAS, the Division of Gaming Enforcement (Division) filed a letter report dated April 2, 2012, in which it recommended that the Commission permit Mr. Cho to assume the duties and exercise the powers of that position before being qualified; and

WHEREAS, the Division does not object to the Commission granting the requested relief prior to the expiration of the period specified in *N.J.A.C.* 13:69C-2.7(c)2;

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the entire record of the proceedings at its public meeting of April 11, 2012; and
