WHEREAS, the Commission has determined to amend the present delegation of authority set forth in Commission Resolution No. 13-01-10-16A to add an additional function; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission is desirous of ensuring that a request by the Division to suspend a casino key employee license is considered in a timely manner so as to ensure public safety and maintain regulatory integrity; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission fully considered this matter at its public meeting of May 12, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the New Jersey Casino Control Commission that:

1. The Chairman/CEO is hereby delegated the power and authority to grant, upon a petition request of the Division, a suspension of a casino key employee license provided good cause is shown and



until such time as the suspension request can be considered by the full Commission.

2. A suspension granted in this matter shall be considered an interim suspension and the Division's petition seeking suspension and revocation shall thereafter be considered by the full Commission at a regularly scheduled public meeting.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this delegation shall include the right to restrict, limit or condition any suspension granted pursuant to the authority granted herein.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the delegation herein shall modify the previous delegation of authority set forth in Resolution No. 13-01-10-16A.
