IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant has demonstrated his qualifications for licensure as a casino key employee by clear and convincing evidence and has established the requisite good character, honesty and integrity and financial stability, integrity and responsibility as required by N.J.S.A. 5:12-80, N.J.S.A. 5:12-86(a), N.J.S.A. 5:12-86(b), N.J.S.A. 5:12-89(b)(1) and N.J.S.A. 5:12-89(b)(2) and is thus hereby found PLENARILY QUALIFIED for the position of Vice-President of Security at Tropicana Atlantic City Corp. and his initial application for casino key employee license #10936-11 is **GRANTED** for the period ending August 31, 2030.
