I didn't realize</p> <p>4 this. I spent hours trying to log in, but I</p> <p>5 can't because I don't have a locator. So now</p> <p>6 I'm trying to do FanDuel. I can't do it. It</p> <p>7 finally dawned on me. Let me break out my</p> <p>8 laptop, and let me see what else can I do.</p> <p>9 Also I had tried to do William Hill. And I log</p> <p>10 into PointsBet.</p> <p>11 Who's PointsBet? They're an offsite,</p> <p>12 Australian company, which I find out. Right?</p> <p>13 So I log into them on a my laptop and, yes, now</p> <p>14 it works and now I'm in. Right? Big mistake.</p> <p>15 Okay.</p> <p>16 So they don't have the capability of a</p> <p>17 FanDuel and DraftKings. In the months when I</p> <p>18 have problems, I complained about the problems.</p> <p>19 I called them out on everything. And I have</p> <p>20 the e-mails to prove it. Okay? I have the</p> <p>21 deposits that I made. I have those copies of</p> <p>22 that, \$50 over 90 percent of all my deposits.</p> <p>23 That's all I did. All small little bets. And</p> <p>24 what I did was, I guess I got on their radar.</p> <p>25 So I don't know how many complaints I</p>

But then I sent</p> <p>3 nine e-mails out, and then a couple weeks</p> <p>4 later, I find myself in this mess. Okay?</p> <p>5 So while I find myself in this mess, I</p> <p>6 sent -- you know, I'm talking through the</p> <p>7 chats. I'm sending them out e-mails. As I'm</p> <p>8 sending out e-mails, it's within an hour</p> <p>9 finding out -- I don't know what's happened to</p> <p>10 me. I don't know why I can't get into the</p> <p>11 website. I don't understand it. I don't</p> <p>12 understand what the word "exclusion" means.</p> <p>13 You know, that's just all new to me. I wanted</p> <p>14 to be excluded from this. So when they asked</p> <p>15 me, do you want to be excluded from this for</p> <p>16 one year? I said, absolutely. You want to be</p> <p>17 excluded from this for five years? I said yes.</p> <p>18 Okay? Thinking I was excluded from this</p> <p>19 questioning. Do I want to have a thousand</p> <p>20 dollar deposit limit? I should have just said,</p> <p>21 yes, I want to have a thousand dollars. None</p> <p>22 of this pertained to me. Right? So...</p> <p>23 Let me see. I'm just referring to some</p> <p>24 of the my e-mails I have. I have many e-mails.</p> <p>25 So within, like I said, an hour I was</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">56</p> <p>1 ITEM NO. 12</p> <p>2 on it because it's embarrassing. They didn't</p> <p>3 think they would have someone like me that's</p> <p>4 going to fight this for 19 months. I have. I</p> <p>5 sent out e-mail after e-mail. And I said, the</p> <p>6 power of consistency. Like Andy Dufresne, who</p> <p>7 was wanting to get books for his library in the</p> <p>8 "Shawshank Redemption." I'm not going to quit.</p> <p>9 I did nothing wrong. You know?</p> <p>10 I spoke to a friend of mine who is an</p> <p>11 attorney. He says, Marty, you need an</p> <p>12 attorney. And I said, you know what? I'm got</p> <p>13 going to have you down here and waste your</p> <p>14 time. I've done nothing wrong. So they bought out by a</p> <p>10 company, Fanatics. So I'm banned by a site</p> <p>11 that doesn't even exist anymore. Now, you can</p> <p>12 say, well, it existed in another thing. They</p> <p>13 got bought out. But again, I never went into</p> <p>14 their responsible portal. I never did. I</p> <p>15 swear to god. I swear to god on my children's,</p> <p>16 my wife's life. I swear to god. I will take a</p> <p>17 lie detector test. I did not do this.</p> <p>18 So another thing she'll say, oh, if we</p> <p>19 let MW back in, this opens up portals. I don't</p> <p>20 think it opens up any portals. I mean, you</p> <p>21 know -- things to other people. I'm totally</p> <p>22 different than anybody you've ever had. I</p> <p>23 think what they did, they did to me, and they</p> <p>24 did it on purpose. And I think they hacked it.</p> <p>25 You know, they're not going to have any record</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">57</p> <p>1 ITEM NO. 12</p> <p>2 probably costing them money. Okay? So I'm</p> <p>3 costing them money. I'm making \$9 bets, \$8</p> <p>4 bets, \$7 bets, \$5 bets. I called them out if</p> <p>5 they owed me a-dollar-twenty-five. I called</p> <p>6 them out. I called them out constantly.</p> <p>7 Right?</p> <p>8 So again, so I was saying this happened</p> <p>9 at 3:00 in the afternoon. She got word that,</p> <p>10 oh, this happened in the evening. Okay? You know, I can't do that.</p> <p>4 You know.</p> <p>5 And again, I did this to myself on the</p> <p>6 mistake that I made by not saying, yes, I want</p> <p>7 a thousand dollar deposit limit. Ninety</p> <p>8 percent of my deposits are \$50. That can be</p> <p>9 proven. I've shared this with everybody.</p> <p>10 And again, I appreciate and thank</p> <p>11 everybody that they've listened to me. No one logs in and they are met with</p> <p>9 this line of questioning. They would have to</p> <p>10 go to the responsible gaming section to find</p> <p>11 both the deposit limits and the self-exclusion</p> <p>12 process.</p> <p>13 And once you go into the responsible</p> <p>14 gaming, you have to select set a deposit limit</p> <p>15 to then have the questions asked to the</p> <p>16 appellant about the setting deposits.</p> <p>17 Additionally, they would then need to</p> <p>18 specifically choose self-exclusion, which is in</p> <p>19 the cool-off section. And the final question -- or the</p> <p>7 final step of that process there was a code</p> <p>8 that was sent to his cell phone. At that time</p> <p>9 he would have had to have gone to his cell</p> <p>10 phone, taken the code, and then put it back on</p> <p>11 the application. And that's -- PointsBet is an</p> <p>9 Australian-based company, and UTC is used in</p> <p>10 Australian. At that time the Appellant</p> <p>11 finalized the self-exclusion process</p> <p>12 immediately after receiving the code.</p> <p>13 The Appellant's actions here were of his</p> <p>14 own free will and solely a result of his choice</p> <p>15 to not carefully read or understand what he was</p> <p>16 selecting when choosing self-exclusion through</p> <p>17 the PointsBet application.</p> <p>18 Allowing the Appellant to be removed</p> <p>19 from the Self-Exclusion List at this time</p> <p>20 simply because he now regrets his decision</p> <p>21 would undermine the self-exclusion process.</p> <p>22 And further, the Division submits that,</p> <p>23 again, none of the New Jersey online operators</p> <p>24 attempt to entice patrons into self exclusion</p> <p>25 by immediately meeting them upon log-in with</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">68</p> <p>1 ITEM NO. 12</p> <p>2 specifically stated, I made a mistake. I'm</p> <p>3 embarrassed by this. I answered wrongly. So</p> <p>4 the Appellant admits many times that he simply</p> <p>5 just did not read through the process. And at</p> <p>6 this time it would undermine the self-exclusion</p> <p>7 process completely if we were to allow this</p> <p>8 appellant off the Self-Exclusion List simply</p> <p>9 because he chose not to read through the</p> <p>10 self-exclusion process which is extremely</p> <p>11 detailed. And it's detailed for a reason, so</p> <p>12 we don't have this -- we don't have anyone</p> <p>13 making a mistake. And he would have had to have</p> <p>15 chosen setting limits or he would have to</p> <p>16 choose to self exclude. There's been a</p> <p>8 \$7,000 -- over \$7,000 loss --</p> <p>9 MW: Is there three years?</p> <p>10 MS. DeANNUNTIS: -- in three years.</p> <p>11 MW: Three years.</p> <p>12 MS. DeANNUNTIS: So at this time, and</p> <p>13 due to the totality of all of the</p> <p>14 circumstances, the Appellant has not submitted</p> <p>15 any new arguments.
