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would like to recognize Responsible Gaming 4 Education Month for the month of September. 5 Promoted by the American Gaming Association and 6 the casino industry of New Jersey. Responsible 7 gaming education month highlights the work of 8 the industry on this important topic. Efforts 9 include the promotion of gaming literacy, 10 consumer education and increased employee train 11 to go better identify customers who have -- who 12

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may display signs of problem gambling. Each year in March the Governor and the Commission acknowledges problem gambling awareness month. And we are pleased to add this effort to our calendar. Many Americans participate in some form of gambling as a form of entertainment. Some people, however, develop problematic habits and tendencies. They can more easily be identified and addressed through education and intervention. I'm aware that the casino industry in New Jersey represented by Mark Giannantonio and the Casino Association of New Jersey fully support the good work of the Council on Compulsive

Responsible gaming is a year-round priority for the DGE, but this month gives us a chance to bring additional attention to the tools and resources that are available to the public.

As the Commission is aware, earlier this year, the Responsible Gaming Task Force issued its report with recommendations to strengthen consumers protections.

The Division has begun putting these recommendations into practice, working more closely with partners across the government and the industry.

The Division also has a new proposed regulation to govern online responsible gaming, which is to be published in the New Jersey "Register" September 16th for public comment.

The Division is also funding a pilot of GamFin, which is a financial education and counseling service available free of charge to all New Jersey residents who are experiencing financial harm due to gambling. This includes both individuals who gamble and those who are

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Gambling in the state of New Jersey and also support its 800-GAMBLER hotline.

The Council provides very worthwhile help and resources to people who require assistance due to a gambling problem.

The Commission likewise is also fully supportive and indeed our own Chief of Staff, David Scanlon has served on the Board of Directors of the Council for several years and will represent us at a statewide conference next week in Princeton.

At this time I would like to recognize the work and efforts of the New Jersey Division of Gaming Enforcement in this area. Representing the Division today is Deputy Attorney General Jamie McKelvey, and I will ask

her to say a few words about this topic today. Jamie? MS. McKELVEY: Thank you. Jamie McKelvey, Deputy Attorney General appearing on behalf of Office of the Attorney General, Division of Gaming Enforcement. I'd like to thank you for the
