I would like to publicly acknowledge and thank everyone who contributed to the success of our annual Casino Career Fair that was held two weeks ago. Working together, we were able to provide a unique opportunity for hundreds of job seekers. A record number of people were hired as a direct result of this year's event.

Collectively, the casinos are recruiting to fill 1,200 jobs. All nine casinos sent hiring representatives to meet in person with career fair attendees. This event would not be possible without the involvement of the casinos, and I am grateful for their ongoing support.

The Commission remains committed to bringing awareness of potential employment opportunities in the casino industry for former offenders. In that vein, the [New Jersey Judiciary](#) was on-site. Also, [Atlantic and Cape May County Probation](#) and [N.J. State Parole](#) were present to meet with clients and discuss opportunities.

Our sister agency, the [N.J. Division of Gaming Enforcement](#), has been supportive from the very beginning. The Division was present again this year to meet with career fair attendees to discuss casino employee registration. I would also like to acknowledge and thank the [Atlantic City Police Department](#) and [CRDA](#), both of which provided support outside the event.

Last but not least, I would like to thank the Commission staff, who enthusiastically embrace the Casino Career Fair every year. They see to every possible detail and always ensure a smooth and successful event.
