Work to be performed under Contract B089 includes, but is not limited to, the furnishing of all safety, supervision, labor, materials, supplies, equipment and all other facilities required to perform miscellaneous concrete repairs or restoration work on an as needed basis for a two (2) year period.

It is the intent of this contract to provide for supplementary repair work and related services with concrete repairs and concrete restoration which are provided on an as needed "Time and Material" basis for various tasks including but not limited to emergency services, unscheduled repairs and system modification tasks. 

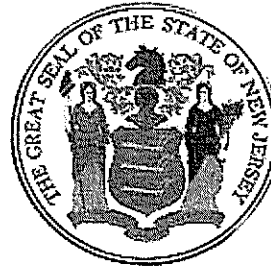
