#### Overview:

In the wake of Superstorm Sandy the need to globally address the stress of the hurricane and to help children build resiliency, and be successful in school, their personal relationships, and in the community became apparent. DCF was awarded funding through the Sandy Social Services Block Grant (SSBG) to address the issue through providing school and community based psychosocial interventions including suicide prevention and trauma response in impacted areas. For the purpose of this initiative, the DCF will make available \$5, 424,000 in 2013-2015. It is anticipated that the resulting contract will contain approximately 2 grants that collectively will provide school and community psychosocial interventions to the 10 highly impacted counties.

Northern Region: Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Middlesex, and Union Counties

Southern Region: Atlantic, Cape May, Monmouth, Cumberland and Ocean Counties
