## 5-Year Action Plan:

As part of the BEAD program, New Jersey developed a Five-Year Action Plan, serving as a comprehensive needs assessment and strategic blueprint

**Initial Proposal Vol. 1:** Following submittal of its Five-Year Action Plan, the State submitted Initial Proposal Volume 1, which focused on the Challenge Process

**Initial Proposal Vol. 2:** In the second volume of its Initial Proposal, New Jersey provided its approach to the subgrantee selection processes

## State Challenge Process:

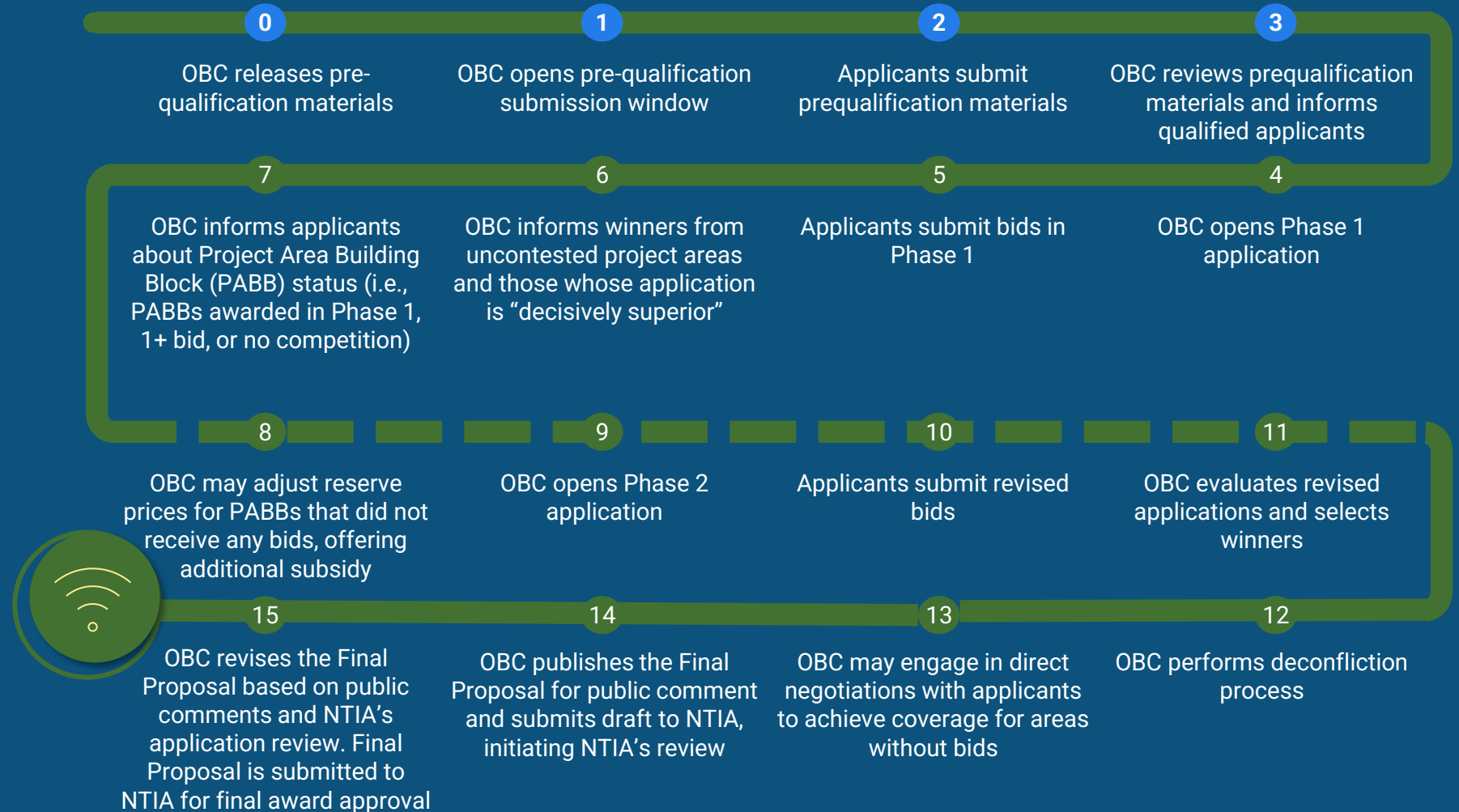

### Introduction

The New Jersey Office of Broadband Connectivity (OBC) is pleased to solicit applications to prequalify for infrastructure funding from the New Jersey Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment (NJ BEAD) program.

The NJ BEAD program represents a significant opportunity to expand broadband across New Jersey, with \$263.7 million allocated by NTIA. During prequalification, potential subgrantees will provide select NTIA-required financial, operational, managerial and technical qualifications. Only providers approved in the first application phase are eligible to apply in subsequent phases. No new providers will be accepted during the second phase.

### Sheet legend

Green sheets provide instructions

Blue sheets provide the prequalification questionnaire

### Response instruction

In the Response column of the prequalification questionnaire sheets, applicants will see cells with different colors as described below. Please note that the color of certain cells may change based on the applicants' responses to specific questions.

Blue cells indicate area already filled in

Grey cells indicate areas not for editing
