# OFFENDER CHARACTERISTICS REPORT

**ON JANUARY 1, 2020** 

Office of Policy and Planning January 2020

### **INTRODUCTION**

This report has been developed to provide information regarding offender characteristics in each correctional complex, major institution, and satellite housing-unit under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Department of Corrections on January 1, 2020. The selected characteristics compiled in this report are Base Offense at Admission, Total Term at Admission, Ethnicity, Age, County of Commitment, and Mandatory Minimum Term.

The Prison Complex includes: New Jersey State Prison, Central Reception and Assignment Facility, East Jersey State Prison, Bayside State Prison, Mid-State Correctional Facility, Southern State Correctional Facility, Northern State Prison, South Woods State Prison, Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women and the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center (ADTC), a facility for adult male sex offenders.

NOTE: In the data tables, separate subtotals are provided for ADTC and Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women due to the interest in these unique populations. The remainder of the Prison Complex is labeled "Male Offenders in Other Facilities."

The Youth Correctional Complex consists of Garden State Youth Correctional Facility and Mountainview Youth Correctional Facility.

"Halfway Houses, County Jails, Reentry, St. Francis" include state-sentenced inmates housed in halfway houses, county jails, Reentry, and Central Medical Unit (St. Francis Hospital).

"Not Coded" are records for offenders in the correctional system for whom admission characteristics data had not been entered into the computerized information system as of January 1, 2020.

### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Sixty-four percent (64%) of all New Jersey Department of Corrections inmates were committed for crimes against persons which include Homicide, Sexual Assault, Aggravated/Simple Assault, Robbery, Kidnapping, Other Sex Offenses and Other Person Offenses.
- Thirteen percent (13%) of all Department of Corrections inmates have been committed for narcotics law violations, including possession, sale and distribution. Eighty-four percent (84.7%) of all narcotics law violations are sale/distribution offenses.
- The median total term for Department of Corrections' inmates is 7 years.
- Forty-two percent (42%) of all New Jersey Department of Corrections inmates were committed with total terms of 10 years or more. Of the total, six percent (6%) are serving Life Sentences with parole eligibility, and 94 offenders are serving Life Sentences without parole.
- Seventy-six percent (76.3%) of New Jersey Department of Corrections inmates housed in the State System have sentences that include mandatory minimum terms.
- Thirty-four percent (34%) of all inmates in the New Jersey Department of Corrections are 30 years of age or younger. The median age for inmates in all facilities is 35.
- Sixty-two percent (62%) of New Jersey Department of Corrections' inmates are Black, 22% White, 16% Hispanic, and 1% Asian.
- Of the 21 New Jersey counties, ten (Atlantic, Bergen, Camden, Essex, Hudson, Mercer, Middlesex, Monmouth, Passaic and Union) account for 77% of Total Department of Corrections inmates. Essex County is the highest contributor with 15%.

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## **BASE OFFENSE**

## OFFENDERS IN NEW JERSEY CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS ON JANUARY 1, 2020, BY BASE OFFENSE

In these tabulations, the base offense is the most serious offense at the time of admission. These figures reflect base or controlling offenses at admission only and do not include any offenses in addition to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission. Additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the state correctional system are not included in these data.

- Violent offenses include homicide, sexual assault, aggravated and simple assault, robbery, kidnapping, other sex offenses and other
  person offenses (i.e. terroristic threats, coercion, larceny from a person, death by auto and negligent manslaughter). Violent offenses
  grouped as "Other Sex" include: Criminal Sexual Attempt, Child Pornography, Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Prostitution, and
  Registration Sex Offender.
- Property offenses include burglary, arson, theft, forgery, embezzlement, and receiving / possessing stolen property.
- Public policy offenses include racketeering, gambling, corruption, perjury, escape, bail jumping, juvenile and family related offenses, and conspiracy.
- Weapons offenses include weapon possession and operation.
- Drug violations include distribution, manufacture, possession, and use of drugs. Virtually all drug offenses are for sale and distribution rather than for mere possession.





Virtually all offenders at ADTC were committed for violent offenses.


#### **MALE OFFENDERS IN OTHER FACILITIES**

Eleven percent (11%) of female inmates were committed for drug offenses.




#### **YOUTH COMPLEX**



Sixty-two percent (62.5%) of offenders housed in the youth complex were incarcerated for violent offenses.

Seven percent (7.5%) of offenders housed in the youth complex were incarcerated for drug offenses and 4.3% for property offenses.

#### HALWAY HOUSES, COUNTY JAILS, REENTRY, ST. FRANCIS



Offenders housed in county jails, halfway houses, Reentry, and St. Francis are less serious offenders than the Male Offenders in Other Facilities (i.e. 31.1% violent offenders vs. 69.6% Male Offenders in Other Facilities with violent offenses).

Twenty-five percent (25.5%) of offenders housed in Halfway Houses, County Jails, Reentry, and St. Francis were committed for drug offenses.

Among New Jersey Adult Correctional Offenders:

- The median term for adult offenders is 7 years.
- Forty-one percent (41%) are serving terms of 1-5 years.
- Seventeen percent (17%) are serving terms of 6-9 years.
- Forty-two percent (42%) are serving terms of 10 years or more, which includes 1,055 offenders serving life and 94 serving life without parole sentences.
- Two percent (2%) were not coded.







#### FEMALE OFFENDERS



The median term at ADTC is 10 years.

The median term for Male Offenders in Other Facilities is 8 years.

Thirty-two percent (32.6%) of all Male Offenders in Other Facilities are serving sentences of 16 years or more.

Eighty-six percent (86%) of all offenders at New Jersey State Prison are serving sentences of 16 years or more, with 470 Life With Parole and 91 Life Without Parole. The median term at Edna Mahan is 5 years.

Forty-seven percent (47.2%) of the female offenders at Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women are serving sentences of 5 years or less.


## Youth Complex Offenders By Total Term At Admission







Eighty-five percent (85.9%) of the ADTC population have mandatory minimum sentences (405 of 471).

Forty-six percent (46.4%) have mandatory minimum terms of 10 years or longer.

Of the 12,773 Male Offenders in Other Facilities, 75.1% (9,601) have mandatory minimum terms.

The median mandatory minimum term for Male Offenders in Other Facilities is 8.4 years (ADTC excluded).

Eighty-nine percent (89.9%) of New Jersey State Prison inmates have mandatory minimum terms, and 86% percent of those have minimum terms of 15 years or more.

The median mandatory minimum term at Edna Mahan is 6.7 years.

At Edna Mahan, 69% of the females housed have minimum terms (383 of 555).

Thirty-four percent (34.2%) of the females with mandatory minimum terms have terms of 5 years or less.








### MALE OFFENDERS IN OTHER FACILITIES










