# **OFFENDER CHARACTERISTICS REPORT**

# **ON JANUARY 4, 2022**

## **INTRODUCTION**

This report has been developed to provide information regarding offender characteristics in each correctional complex, major institution, and satellite housing-unit under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Department of Corrections on January 4, 2022. The selected characteristics compiled in this report are Base Offense at Admission, Total Term at Admission, Ethnicity, Age, County of Commitment, and Mandatory Minimum Term.

The Prison Complex includes: New Jersey State Prison, East Jersey State Prison, Bayside State Prison, Mid-State Correctional Facility, Southern State Correctional Facility, Northern State Prison, South Woods State Prison, Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women and the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center (ADTC), a facility for adult male sex offenders.

*NOTE:* In the data tables, separate subtotals are provided for ADTC and Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women due to the interest in these unique populations. The remainder of the Prison Complex is labeled "Male Offenders in Other Facilities."

The Youth Offenders consists of Garden State Youth Correctional Facility.

"Halfway Houses, County Jails, St. Francis" include state-sentenced inmates housed in halfway houses, county jails, and Central Medical Unit (St. Francis Hospital).

"Not Coded" are records for offenders in the correctional system for whom admission characteristics data had not been entered into the computerized information system as of January 4, 2022.

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Seventy-two percent (72%) of all New Jersey Department of Corrections inmates were committed for crimes against persons which include Homicide, Sexual Assault, Aggravated/Simple Assault, Robbery, Kidnapping, Other Sex Offenses and Other Person Offenses.
- Nine percent (9%) of all Department of Corrections inmates have been committed for narcotics law violations, including possession, sale and distribution. Eighty-eight percent (88%) of all narcotics law violations are sale/distribution offenses.
- The median total term for Department of Corrections' inmates is 8 years.
- Fifty-one percent (51%) of all New Jersey Department of Corrections inmates were committed with total terms of 10 years or more. Of the total, eight percent (8%) are serving Life Sentences with parole eligibility, and 92 offenders are serving Life Sentences without parole.
- Seventy-seven percent (77%) of New Jersey Department of Corrections inmates housed in the State System have sentences that include mandatory minimum terms.
- Twenty-nine percent (29%) of all inmates in the New Jersey Department of Corrections are 30 years of age or younger. The median age for inmates in all facilities is 37.
- Sixty-one percent (61%) of New Jersey Department of Corrections' inmates are Black, 22% White, 16% Hispanic, and 1% Asian.
- Of the 21 New Jersey counties, ten (Atlantic, Bergen, Camden, Essex, Hudson, Mercer, Middlesex, Monmouth, Passaic and Union) account for 76% of Total Department of Corrections inmates. Essex County is the highest contributor with 14%.

## **BASE OFFENSE**

#### OFFENDERS IN NEW JERSEY CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS ON JANUARY 4, 2022, BY BASE OFFENSE

In these tabulations, the base offense is the most serious offense at the time of admission. These figures reflect base or controlling offenses at admission only and do not include any offenses in addition to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission. Additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the state correctional system are not included in these data.

- Violent offenses include homicide, sexual assault, aggravated and simple assault, robbery, kidnapping, other sex offenses and other person offenses (i.e. terroristic threats, coercion, larceny from a person, death by auto and negligent manslaughter). Violent offenses grouped as "Other Sex" include: Criminal Sexual Attempt, Child Pornography, Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Prostitution, and Registration Sex Offender.
- Property offenses include burglary, arson, theft, forgery, embezzlement, and receiving / possessing stolen property.
- Public policy offenses include racketeering, gambling, corruption, perjury, escape, bail jumping, juvenile and family related offenses, and conspiracy.
- Weapons offenses include weapon possession and operation.
- Drug violations include distribution, manufacture, possession, and use of drugs. Virtually all drug offenses are for sale and distribution rather than for mere possession.





#### **FEMALE OFFENDERS**




Virtually all offenders at ADTC were committed for violent offenses.

Eight percent (8.4%) of all Male Offenders in Other Facilities were convicted of drug offenses.




Violent offenses were the most frequent commitment-offenses at Edna Mahan (66.9%).


Fifty-nine percent (59.8%) of offenders housed in the youth facility were incarcerated for violent offenses.

Offenders housed in county jails, halfway houses, and St. Francis are less serious offenders than the Male Offenders in Other Facilities (i.e. 39.7% violent offenders vs. 76.8% Male Offenders in Other Facilities with violent offenses). Twenty-two percent (22.7%) of offenders housed in Halfway Houses, County Jails, and St. Francis were committed for drug offenses.

Among New Jersey Adult Correctional Offenders:

- The median term for adult offenders is 8 years.
- Thirty-four percent (34%) are serving terms of 1-5 years.
- Sixteen percent (16%) are serving terms of 6-9 years.
- Fifty-one percent (51%) are serving terms of 10 years or more, which includes 961 offenders serving life and 92 serving life without parole sentences.
- One percent (1%) were not coded.



#### MALE OFFENDERS IN OTHER FACILITIES




The median term for Male Offenders in Other Facilities is 10 years.

Seventy-seven percent (77%) of all offenders at New Jersey State Prison are serving sentences of 16 years or more, with 428 Life With Parole and 90 Life Without Parole.

#### FEMALE OFFENDERS




The median term at Edna Mahan is 7 years.


















### Prison Complex Offenders By Race/Ethnic Identification




