## STATEMENT OF THE CASE AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Appellant Arcides Marengo appeals his removal from employment with the respondent Essex County Department of Corrections. This matter was scheduled for a status conference on January 6, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. However, the conference was not conducted due to the appellant's failure to appear telephonically, despite numerous and repeated attempts to reach him. Appellant has repeatedly failed to appear for

proceedings in this matter, including a status conference on August 20, 2014, as well as the plenary hearing scheduled September 22, 2014. As a liberal courtesy, I adjourned the matter and placed it on the inactive list, at the appellant's request, over the objection of the respondent. At the granting of the adjournment, appellant also acknowledged that he agreed to waive claims to back pay given that he initiated the delay.

Accordingly, I can no longer excuse the appellant's failure to appear, nor allow further delay and postponement.

## **ORDER**

It is hereby **ORDERED** that this matter be **DISMISSED** as a result of the appellant's failure to appear.

I hereby **FILE** my initial decision with the **CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION** for consideration.

This recommended decision may be adopted, modified or rejected by the CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION, which by law is authorized to make a final decision in this matter. If the Civil Service Commission does not adopt, modify or reject this decision within forty-five days and unless such time limit is otherwise extended, this recommended decision shall become a final decision in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:14-204.
