The Department of Labor and Workforce Development requests the extension of the eligible list for Claims Adjudicator Trainee Disability Determinations (S0694U).

By way of background, the Claims Adjudicator Trainee Disability Determinations (S0694U) eligible list promulgated on April 20, 2017 and expires on April 19, 2018. This list has never been certified and there are 217 active eligibles. There is no announcement pending for Claims Adjudicator Trainee Disability Determinations.

In the instant matter, the Division of Disability Determination Services is anticipating filling positions and will need to quickly fill the vacant positions once the approval is received. The appointing authority requests that the subject list be extended for one year. The filling of a vacancy from an active list is preferable to, and more expedient than, announcing a new examination.

**CONCLUSION**

*N.J.S.A* 11A:4-6 and *N.J.A.C.* 4A:4-3.4 provide that an eligible list may, for good cause, be extended, except that no list shall have a duration of more than four years.

In the instant matter, the appointing authority seeks the one year extension of the Claims Adjudicator Trainee Disability Determinations (S0694U) eligible list so that it may make permanent appointments rather than provisional appointments


while waiting for another list to promulgate. There are 217 candidates who have already been tested and remain on the list and no announcement is pending for this title. Under these circumstances, good cause has been shown to extend the subject list.

**ORDER**

Therefore, it is ordered that this request be granted, and the eligible list for Claims Adjudicator Trainee Disability Determinations (S0694U), Department of Labor and Workforce Development, be extended for one year or until a new list become available, whichever occurs first.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the judicial forum.
