B-86 TIMOTHY HART – CSC DOCKET NO. 2011-2387

Timothy Hart, a former Police Officer with the City of Newark, represented by William W. Hart, Jr., Esq., appeals the determination of his layoff rights by the Division of State and Local Operations.

B-87 TODD KELLY, ET AL. – CSC DOCKET NO. 2014-2580

Todd Kelly, James Kearns, and Gerard McDonald, Police Sergeants with the City of Elizabeth, represented by Bruce Leder, Esq., challenge appointments made from the January 13, 2014 certification of the Police Lieutenant (PM5107M), City of Elizabeth, eligible list.

ACTION:

B-88 ANTHONY DIMITRI – CSC DOCKET NO. 2015-330

Anthony Dimitri appeals his rejection as a Correction Officer Recruit candidate by the Department of Corrections and its request to remove his name from the eligible list for Correction Officer Recruit (S9988R) on the basis of a positive drug test.

B-89 YANG CAO – CSC DOCKET NO. 2015-1292

Yang Cao, represented by David B. Beckett, Esq., appeals the decision of the Division of Classification and Personnel Management that the proper classification of her position with the Department of Environmental Protection is Program Specialist 3. The appellant seeks a Research Scientist 1 job classification.

ACTION:

B-90 P. F. – CSC DOCKET NO. 2014-2508

P. F., an Administrator of Plant Services with the Department of Human Services, appeals the determination of the Acting Equal Employment Opportunity Director, which did not substantiate any of the appellant's allegations but found sufficient evidence that the appellant had violated the New Jersey State Policy Prohibiting Discrimination in the Workplace.

ACTION:

B-91 K. G. – CSC DOCKET NO. 2014-1070

K. G., a Teacher 3, 12 Months, with the Cape May Regional School, Department of Children and Families, appeals the determination of the Director, Office of Equal Employment Opportunity and Affirmative Action, stating that the appellant failed to present sufficient evidence to support a finding that she had been subjected to a violation of the New Jersey State Policy Prohibiting Discrimination in the Workplace. The appellant also appeals the finding that she violated the State Policy.

Cristina Mateo appeals the determination of the Division of Selection Services and Recruitment that she did not meet the experience requirements for the promotional examination for Assistant Housing Manager (PM0494S), Orange Housing Authority.

The Division of Agency Services recommends the creation of the non-competitive title of Housing and Zoning Inspector Trainee and Housing and Zoning Inspector. Agency Services also recommends the inactivation of the Maintenance Repairer/Radio Dispatcher and Building Service Worker/Clerk 2 titles.

ACTION:**B-94 REALLOCATION OF DIRECTOR, PUBLIC LABORATORY SERVICES AND DIRECTOR, ENVIRONMENTAL AND CHEMICAL LABORATORY SERVICES TITLES FROM THE COMPETITIVE TO THE NON-COMPETITIVE DIVISION OF THE CAREER SERVICE- CSC DOCKET NO. 2015-2635**

The Division of Agency Services recommends the reactivation and reallocation of the Director, Public Health Laboratory Services and Director, Environmental and Chemical Laboratory Services titles to the non-competitive division of the career service in accordance with *N.J.A.C. 4A:3-1.2*. Agency Services also requests that four titles in the Clinic Nurse title series be designated inactive or archaic.
