The Superior Court of New Jersey, Appellate Division, in *In the Matter of Christopher Ferro*, Docket No. A-003160-21T1 (App. Div., October 11, 2022), remanded *In the Matter of Christopher Ferro* (CSC, decided May 18, 2022) to address Ferro's request for reconsideration. The Civil Service Commission is also addressing the Bergen County Sheriff's Office request for stay in this matter.

B-21 THOMAS VALENTE – DOCKET NO. 2023-825

The Superior Court of New Jersey, Appellate Division, in *In the Matter of Thomas Valente, Jr., West Milford, Police Department*, Docket No. A-3180-21 (App. Div., October 14, 2022), reversed the Civil Service Commission's (Commission) decision in *In the Matter of Thomas Valente* (CSC, decided April 6, 2022) and remanded the matter to allow the Commission to issue a final decision affirming the Administrative Law Judge's initial decision.
