**TRENTON, NJ** - The New Jersey Civil Service Commission (CSC) will be hosting the second of a series of Statewide Job Fairs on Thursday, April 18, 2024, at Mercer County Community College, 1200 Old Trenton Road, West Windsor, NJ from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM.

Over 40 state and local departments, agencies, colleges, and universities are expected to be in attendance to share their organization's mission, open job opportunities, career advancement opportunities, and to answer any questions job seekers may have.

"CSC held its first job fair this year at Rowan College of South Jersey earlier this month. It was a great success," said Allison Chris Myers, Chair & Chief Executive Officer of the New Jersey Civil Service Commission, "and we anticipate likewise for this event.
