TRENTON, **NJ** - The New Jersey Civil Service Commission (CSC) will be hosting a Statewide Job Fair on Thursday, August 15, 2024, at Kean University, Liberty Hall Academic Center, 1003 Morris Avenue, Building 2 in Union, NJ from 9:30 AM to 1:30 PM.

Over 30 state and local departments, agencies, colleges, and universities are expected to attend to share their organization's mission, open job opportunities and career advancement opportunities, and answer any questions job seekers may have.
