<u>New Jersey Civil Service Commission Approves</u> <u>Notice of Proposal for New Telework Rule</u>

TRENTON - The New Jersey Civil Service Commission (Commission) at its meeting on Wednesday, April 9, 2025, approved a Notice of Proposal to promulgate a new rule in order to implement a telework program for certain State employees, as well as amend existing rules with regard to hours of work and alternative workweek programs to be consistent with the proposed telework rule.

As noted in the Notice of Proposal, the COVID-19 pandemic required numerous employees throughout the State to shift to partial or full telework, demonstrating that the State workforce could effectively work remotely while maintaining essential services. This resulted in the Commission approving and establishing a Model Telework Pilot Program in April 2022 for State Executive Branch employees. The program permitted employees to work remotely up to two days per week. This allowed the State to evaluate the benefit of such a program and to remain competitive in the job market by attracting top talent and providing flexibility for its employees. The Model Telework Program was thereafter extended to facilitate formal rulemaking procedures.

As the proposal is still subject to technical edits by the Office of Administrative Law, the formal public comment period will begin on May 5, 2025.
