The State proposes to reallocate \$1,260,000 to the Housing Counseling Program. The funds come from a surplus in the Reconstruction, Rehabilitation, Elevation and Mitigation (RREM), Tenant-Based Rental Assistance Program and Resettlement Programs.

The Housing Counseling Program is a collaboration of HUD-certified, non-profit, community-based organizations which provide a wide range of counseling services to both renters and homeowners impacted by Superstorm Sandy. The reallocation is necessary to fund this Program in accordance with the State's Voluntary Compliance Agreement and will ensure that services continue to be available to those who need them.
