Stat. § 47:1A-1 et seq. ("OPRA"), for the reasons set forth below.

1. Personal Identifying Information

The Confidential Information includes personal identifying information the release of which would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy and is properly exempt from disclosure under the NJ OPRA.

Pursuant to this, it is our position that Confidential Information includes all personal identifying information including the personal contact information for Dewberry, its subconsultants, and personnel, as well as points of contacts for professional references that are not state agencies or related entities, wherever included, throughout the submitted materials. This Confidential Information includes personal tax information.

2. Proprietary Commercial or Financial Information; Information That Would Give Competitors an Advantage; and Trade Secrets

The Confidential Information includes proprietary commercial or financial information and trade secrets. The disclosure of this Confidential Information would cause substantial injury to the competitive position of Dewberry and would give an advantage to competitors or bidders. Accordingly, this Confidential Information is properly exempt from disclosure Exemption No. 8 under the NJ OPRA.

Dewberry's qualifications, related experience, team organization, and quality assurance program identify Dewberry's confidential and proprietary performance methodologies. This Protected Information includes Dewberry's unique and internally developed contract management processes, methodologies, and support systems. Many such processes and methodologies were specifically developed and tailored to address the exact scope of work and unique challenges that are known to be present for the Project or likely to be encountered. These processes and methodologies were developed, tested, and proven in working on similar projects in the same area, and have then also been deployed for the use on other similar projects having their own unique set of challenges, from which Dewberry has incorporated adaptability into the fabric of its unique contract management processes and approach.

Dewberry's professional resumes and narratives of personnel qualifications identify the key employees of Dewberry, and the unique education and work experience each brings, and when taken collectively, provide a highly qualified experienced team, and constitutes Dewberry's staffing approach formula for performing an environmental review on transit projects. Additionally, throughout the professional resumes and narratives of personnel qualifications, Dewberry identifies not only the critical experience that is necessary for completing this type of work but also reveals other education, experience, and credentials, that create added value and provide Dewberry with a specially formulated competitive advantage by leveraging this proprietary staffing approach. The Confidential Information also identifies unique internally developed methodologies used by Dewberry, and by Dewberry's personnel, on similar projects, that identify internally developed performance methodologies that detail Dewberry's technical approach for how to successfully compete for, and complete, contracts for performing the environmental review for transit projects. This information is not accessible by employees of Dewberry except those needing to know and is not available to the public. Additionally, Dewberry enters into confidentiality agreements with third parties in the event Dewberry does share such information, such as when teaming with other firms on pursuits.

NJ courts have held that information is exempt under the NJ OPRA as a trade secret, proprietary commercial and financial information, that would give a competitive advantage to competitors and bidders when there was a manifest expectation of privacy from the source of the information, the source took measures to guard the secrecy of the information, the information was not known widely throughout the source of the information, and if a competitor knowing the information and strategy would gain an advantage, and information that can be used in the operation of a business or other enterprise and that is sufficiently valuable and secret to afford a potential economic advantage over others. *Commc'ns Workers of Am. v. Rousseau*, 417 N.J. Super. 341, 362, 9 A.3d 1064, 1077 (App. Div. 2010).

Federal courts have held information be exempt as trade secrets and commercial or financial information if the information is "(a) commercial or financial, (b) obtained from a person, and (c) privileged or confidential." *Nat'l Parks & Conservation Assoc. v. Morton*, 498 F.2d 765, 766 (D.C. Cir. 1974).

According to the Restatement (Third) of Unfair Competition, "A trade secret is any information that can be used in the operation of a business or other enterprise and that is sufficiently valuable and secret to afford an actual or potential economic advantage over others." Restatement (Third) of Unfair Competition § 39 (1995).

Here, all these elements are present. Cleary, the Confidential Information is of a commercial and financial nature, as it is used in the performance of commercial operations, for the generation of revenue and financial gains. To that end, Confidential Information derives independent economic value. The Confidential Information is not known by the public and is known only by those in Dewberry needing to know. Dewberry's unique staffing approach and Confidential Information concerning key personnel would provide a list of key hires for a competitor or firm wishing to break into the market, thereby inviting raids on stealing away Dewberry's employees, whom Dewberry has invested considerable resources in sources, staffing, and training and developing. The Confidential Information would also provide

Dewberry's competitors with Dewberry's internally developed performance methodologies, contract management, and technical approach for how to successfully compete for, and complete, contracts for performing environmental projects. Dewberry had a manifest expectation of privacy under the existence of the NJ OPRA each of which protects this Confidential Information from disclosure. Additionally, Dewberry undertakes measures to guard and protect the secrecy of the information, as evident by the submission of this letter, restricting this information to only those in Dewberry needing to know, and entering into confidentiality agreements with third parties. The release of this information would undoubtedly give Dewberry's competitors a competitive advantage, by allowing those competitors to raid Dewberry's employees and implement Dewberry's proprietary proposal and performance strategies in their proposals for similar contracts for which Dewberry also competes. Additionally, even if these Dewberry's confidential and proprietary performance methodologies were to be devised by a competitor, the way Dewberry conducted the research and development required to develop these concepts and performance methodologies created independent economic value and constitutes confidential commercial and financial information and a trade secret. Understanding this Confidential Information would allow competitors to avoid using a more cost and time-intensive method for developing the work product than the unique method and application of different technologies and data types used by Dewberry to accomplish the same work product.

As an integral part of its business in the region, Dewberry has submitted bids on many projects for similar services as those required by the RFP. Moreover, and most concerning, Dewberry plans to continue submitting proposals to NJ TRANSIT solicitations as a critical part of its plan to continue its business, and retention of employees, in the State of New Jersey. The disclosure of this information would result in a chilling effect that would prevent bidders from providing similar information in future bids for fear of losing competitive advantages that have taken significant investment to create. Consequently, the immediate and irreparable harm that would result from disclosure of the Confidential Information is here a palpable reality.

For the reasons set forth above, the Confidential Information is exempt from disclosure. We have enclosed a redacted copy of the materials with the Confidential Information described hereinabove removed. We do not object to the disclosure of the enclosed redacted version of the materials. In the event NJ TRANSIT disagrees, we request we be given advance notice of disclosure of the Confidential Information.
