This letter from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA), Division for Disaster Recovery and Mitigation (DRM), serves as notification that your firm has been selected to provide environmental review services for Tropical Storm Ida recovery projects. Congratulations on your award!

The waiver of advertisement is necessary to ensure that qualified Consulting Firms are contracted to provide environmental and historic preservation reviews for properties impacted by Tropical Storm Ida that will be served through the housing recovery programs managed by the DRM. These programs are funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) with Community Development Block Grants - Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds. DCA will be unable to perform any reconstruction or rehabilitation work as part of its housing recovery programs until the environmental assessments are conducted for the respective damaged properties.
