

Recognized Certified Maintenance Technicians

CERTIFICATION

The Department adopted a rule in April of 2009 that established qualifications for those who perform maintenance on amusement rides (see NJAC 5:17 – 2.17 and 2.18). The rule became fully effective on April 6, 2011, meaning anyone currently doing maintenance work, as defined in the rules, on a ride must be a Recognized Certified Maintenance Technician. There are several certifications that the Department recognizes. The following is a list of the qualifications that the Department recognizes:

General Certifications

- NAARSO Level 1 or better Certification
- AIMS level 1 or better Certification
- DCA Issued Certification (see attached list)
- PA General Inspector qualified to inspect category 2 rides as defined in PA Chapter 139
- PA Qualified Affiliated Inspector qualified to inspect category 2 rides as defined in PA Chapter 139
- Manufacturer or manufacturer's contractor working on their own equipment

For Water Parks Only

- Certified Pool Operator issued by the National Swimming Pool Foundation
- Aquatic Facilities Operator Certification issued by the National Recreation and Park Association

For Electrical Work Only

- Electrical Contractors License

Note – applicants who hold a NAARSO or AIMS certification can transfer that certification to a DCA issued certification. The application is available on the Departments website on the licensing unit page under the Division of Codes and Standards.

CONTINUING EDUCATION

Individuals who have a State issued RCMT certification are required to take 32 hours of continuing education credit over a two year period. (Note that those people who are AIMS, NAARSO, or Pennsylvania certified must keep their certification up to date by following the certifying body's continuing education requirements). Below is a list of sources of continuing education that the Department will recognize for the purpose of maintaining a Department issued certification.

Approved Courses:

- State of New Jersey Courses relative to the Amusement Ride Subcode offered through the Rutgers University
- NAARSO Recognized or Sponsored Courses
- AIMS Recognized or Sponsored Courses
- ROAR Recognized or Sponsored Courses
- Training recognized by Pennsylvania for maintaining Pennsylvania General Inspectors and Pennsylvania Individual Qualified Inspectors certifications
- Training other than that listed above can be submitted to the Education Unit within the Division of Codes and Standards for approval. Submissions must include dates and locations of training, amount of time for the training as well as an outline or course material that indicates what will be taught.
