



New Jersey Department of Community Affairs Licensing Unit Propane Service Certification

At this time the **Propane Gas Customer Protection Act** has adopted regulations regarding Propane service installations and repairs that are preformed on propane containers or appliances. All individual who are responsible for installation repair, maintenance, removal or other service shall be certified by the Department. The fee for certification is Fifty Dollars (\$50). Certifications are required as of October 5, 2010.

The requirements for Propane Service Certification are as follows:

1. Propane Service Certification – Container Service and Installation

Successfully complete:

- Book 1 “Basic Principles and Practices” and
- Book4.2 “Preparing and Installing Vapor Distribution System Components” of the Certified Employee Training Program (CETP) administrated by the National Propane Gas Association.

2. Propane Service Certification – Appliance Installation and Service

Successfully complete:

- Book 1 “Basic Principles and Practices”,
- Book 6.0 “Appliance Installation” and
- Book 7.0 “Appliance Service” of the Certified Employee Training Program(CETP) administrated by the National Propane Gas Association.
