



They are requesting the sign be mounted on an exterior wall, or area near the main entrance and must be visible to the public. The Division of Fire Safety strongly urges that fire and EMS stations that meet the staffing requirement participate in the program.

Any fire station or ambulance, first aid, or rescue squad that is willing to participate in the program can request a sign. Participating agencies will be provided with the protocols to be followed if an infant is surrendered.

Production of crude oil from the Bakken region is currently down, but concerns surrounding the transportation of highly volatile crude oil still remains. The Association of American Railroads (AAR) in cooperation with seven major railroads, is offering a four-hour long training that targets first responders who have railroads passing through their jurisdictions. It covers planning and working with the railroads: basic tank recognition and design; properties of the different types of crude; tactics and incident management; and more. The training is available at no cost to first responders; there is a small fee to all others. The program is self-directed and can be taken at the student's pace, and provides a foundation of critical needs and practices students can put to work if faced with a crude by rail incident.
