Concerning the matter of III.B.2. A motion was made by Mr. Avery and second by Ms. Rodriguez to issue a Notice of Determination to two (2) local government officers (LGO) dismissing the allegations in the complaint for a lack of a reasonable factual basis. A roll call was taken: 5 affirmatives. Motion passed.

Concerning the matter of III.B.3. A motion was made by Mr. Close and second by Ms. Rodriguez to authorize a Notice of Investigation to one LGO for an alleged violation of N.J.S.A. 40A:9-22.5(c) and N.J.S.A. 40A:9-22(d). A roll call was taken: 5 affirmatives. Motion passed.

Concerning the matter of III.B.4. A motion was made by Mr. Avery and second by Ms. Rodriguez to issue a Notice of Determination to three (3) LGOs dismissing the complaint for lack of jurisdiction. A roll call was taken: 5 affirmatives. Motion passed.

Concerning the matter of III.B.5. A motion was made by Mr. Avery and second by Ms. Rodriguez to adopt the findings of facts and modify the conclusions of law from the Office of Administrative Law's Initial Decision as a Final Agency Decision. A roll call was taken: 5 affirmatives. Motion passed.
