## **QUESTIONS**

Q. On page 3, Section I – General Information, the RFP discusses the first RFP and states that DCF identified nurse providers in five Counties. The awardees for the Counties that were part of the first round are all organizations which specialize in services for Maternal and Child Health.

Is this required in order to be a successful respondent?

A. No, it is not a requirement. However, awarded respondents must be able to fulfill the required performance and staffing deliverables as outlined in Section II of the RFP.

Q. Please confirm that the successful respondent can be a for-profit or notfor-profit organization?

A. Yes, awarded respondents may be for-profit or not-for-profit organizations. Specific respondent eligibility requirements are on page 14 of the RFP.
