The RFP directs us to contact PCANJ, which in turn, directed us to the local provider for a letter indicating that we have initiated the application process... This section also seems to require that we “complete the application.”

Please explain what application you are referring to, and whether any documents beside the letter from the PCANJ local provider is required.

The letter from the PCANJ local provider is considered the “confirmation” that you initiated the application process.
