Dear Mr. Rocco:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Cumberland County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated July 20, 2017. The subject request proposes County Plan inclusion to add a wood recycling operation to the existing South State, Inc. Class B Recycling Facility located at Block 1, Lots 21.03, 28 & 30. The proposed wood recycling operation will occur on Block 1, Lots 18, 20, 21.03, 28 and 30, in Fairfield Township and the revised daily capacities from the previously approved Class B facility is reflected as follows:

- 2,700 tons/day incoming material for asphalt, concrete, brick, & block;
- 1,000 tons/day incoming material for petroleum contaminated soil; and
- 50 tons/day incoming material for wood recycling (trees, tree parts, branches, clean non-painted and non-treated wood).

Total 3,750 tons/day for all incoming material.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the modification of an existing facility to include wood, with on-site operational changes can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion to add wood to South State Inc. is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
