Dear Mr. Deacon:

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Sustainable Waste Management, Bureau of Solid Waste Planning and Licensing is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Morris County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated April 16, 2025. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of daily throughput capacity of 850 cubic yards (CY) of Class C material for the Mount Olive (Camp Pulaski) Vegetative Waste Multi-Class B&C Recycling Facility in the Township of Mount Olive. The request also proposes to amend the block and lot designation of this facility to Block 400, Lot 4, and Block 401, Lot 1 and proposes to replace any references of "natural wood" in the County Plan with tree limbs and tree parts.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the modification of an existing facility, including acceptance of additional waste types or on-site operational changes, can be accomplished via administrative action. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the amendment of block and lot designation and replacement of the phrase "natural wood" can be accomplished via administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of daily throughput capacity, amendment of block and lot designation, and amendment of material types at the Mount Olive (Camp Pulaski) Vegetative Waste Multi-Class B&C Recycling Facility is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11.
