Dear Mr. Sullivan:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Union County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated September 16, 2015. The administrative action request proposes to amend the County Plan to include a daily capacity tonnage limit of 200 tons per day for waste types 10, 27 and 27A, subject to the annual throughput tonnage limit of 9,934 tons, at the Cycle Chem, Inc. solid and hazardous waste facility, located at 217 South First Street in Elizabeth, New Jersey. Previously in the County Plan, there was no daily capacity tonnage limit, only an annual throughput capacity.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 5., on-site operational changes at an existing facility may be considered for approvable through administrative action process. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Pleased be advised that this administrative action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a permit modification to the subject facility for the above noted operational changes.
