The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Sustainable Waste Management, Bureau of Solid Waste Planning and Licensing is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Union County Solid Waste Management Plan (Plan) dated September 30, 2024. This amendment proposes Plan inclusion of an updated block and lot designation, hours of operation, and a decrease to the maximum daily processing capacity regarding Casings of New Jersey, Inc. Class B Recycling Facility. The facility was previously designated as Block 202, Lots 12, 13, 14 and a portion of Lot 15. The amended facility location is Block 202, Lot 12 and a portion of Lot 15 at 711 Ramsey Avenue in the Township of Hillside. The amendment proposes inclusion of the facility's operating hours of 8:00AM-5:00PM, Monday through Friday, with a closure between 12:00 noon and 1:00 PM every day. Additionally, the amendment proposes a decrease of the maximum daily processing capacity from 185 tons per day to 15 tons per day.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, inclusion of a facility's block and lot designation, hours of operation, and a decrease in the maximum daily processing capacity in the Union County Solid Waste Management Plan can be accomplished via administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan clarification is hereby approved as an Administrative Action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6:11.
