The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Sustainable Waste Management, Bureau of Solid Waste Planning and Licensing is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Cape May County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated April 23, 2024. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of a name change for the Daley's Pit Holding Company, LLC Class B Recycling Center located at Lot 3, Block 453, Dennisville-Petersburg Road in the Township of Upper to Seashore Asphalt Corporation. The above noted change in name will not result in any operational changes at the subject facility which is included in the County Plan for 500 tons per day of concrete, asphalt, brick, and block and operates 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion of a change in the name of an existing recycling facility can be accomplished via administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of a change in name of the Daley's Pit Holding Company, LLC Class B Recycling Center to Seashore Asphalt Corporation is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 7:26-6.11.
