The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has finalized the following document for the administration of the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2020/State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2021 Clean Water State Revolving Fund.


The Intended Use Plan must be developed by the Department, undergo a public participation process and be approved by the US Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for the Department to be awarded its capitalization grant used to finance water infrastructure projects.

The FFY 2020 CWSRF IUP was proposed in December 2019 with a 30-day comment period. No changes were made to the Clean Water SRF program, as described in the proposed FFY 2020 IUP. The FFY 2020/SFY 2021 CWSRF IUP has been finalized and posted on the Department's website.

The Governor of the State of New Jersey recently signed the COVID-19 Mitigation Act (P.L. 20 c.19) extending SFY 2020 and truncating SFY 2021. Please be advised, this law does not impact the term of the Department's Intended Use Plans. Therefore, there are no changes to the duration of the program years for SFY 2020 and SFY 2021. The IUP for SFY 2020 began July 1, 2019 and will end on June 30, 2020 and the IUP for SFY 2021 will begin on July 1, 2020 and end June 30, 2021.
