

FARMER TURKEY PERMIT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

WHO MAY APPLY:

Only the owner or lessee of a farm, who resides thereon, or the immediate members of his family, who also reside there, may apply for special farmer turkey permits. Farmer permit applicants must be over 10 years of age.

The 2000 – 2001 Game Code defines a farm as an area of five acres or more producing a gross income in excess of \$500 and is tax assessed as farm land.

WHAT YOU MAY APPLY FOR:

Qualified farmer applicants may apply for a farmer turkey hunting permit in the Turkey Hunting Period "F" which covers Hunting Periods A, B, C, D, and E. The bag limit is still one tom turkey. Farmer permits are valid only on the farm listed on the application.

If the applicant's farm is located in more than one zone and is otherwise a contiguous property, you may apply for a farmer turkey permit valid for the applicable zones. Only one farmer turkey permit will be issued to the applicant. You must indicate the zones on your application. If your farm is located in more than one turkey management zone, send your application to Carole Kandoth, NJ Division of Fish, Game & Wildlife, PO Box 400, Trenton, NJ 08625-0400.

HOW TO COMPLETE THIS APPLICATION:

1. Hunter Information: Print the hunter's name, birth date, address, social security number, telephone number and driver's license number in spaces provided. Federal law requires the collection of social security numbers.
2. Farm Information: Provide the Turkey Hunting Area, farm acreage, township, county, exact location and tax lot and block number for the farm.
3. Indicate the Turkey Hunting Area and Hunting Period for which you are applying. (See note above if your farm is in more than one zone.)
4. Mail complete application to: **NJ Division of Fish & Wildlife, PO Box 400, Trenton, NJ 08625-0400.**
5. Application period is February 1 - 22. Applicants will receive their permit two weeks prior to the start of the season.
6. No fee is required.
7. Permits are not transferable. Refer to the January 2001 issue of the Turkey Supplement for season dates, bag limits and other regulations.
8. Permits are valid only for the farm location listed on the application.
9. **FALL SEASON:** If you are interested in receiving a Fall Season Turkey Permit, enter your farm hunting area in the Fall Turkey Permit section on the front of this application. Season dates are list below. The bag limit is one turkey of either sex for the Fall Season.

SEASON DATES:

Period A: April 23 – April 27, 2001

Period D: May 14 - 18 and May 21 - 25, 2001

Period B: April 30 - May 4, 2001

Period E: Saturdays April 28, May 5, May 12, and May 19, 2001

Period C: May 7 - May 11, 2001

FALL SEASON: October 29 – November 4, 2001
