

THE TOURNAMENT

The Governor's Annual Surf Fishing Tournament is held to encourage both youngsters and adults to learn more about the sport of surf fishing and take advantage of a great family activity. Funds raised by the tournament go toward marine education and restoration efforts, construction of access ramps for disabled saltwater anglers, and provide surf fishing access, surf fishing instruction programs and equipment as well as the purchase of specialized wheelchairs that provide beach access to the disabled and elderly. Appreciation of our marine resources through surf fishing will hopefully build a stronger advocacy for marine resource conservation.

Exhibits featuring sportsmen's clubs, conservation organizations and tackle manufacturers will be at Pavilion #1.

Entry to the park is free to individuals who register for the surf fishing tournament.

NOTE: The purchase of a beach buggy permit is required to drive on the beach. Permit applications will be available at the park entrance. Call 732-793-0506 for information and fees.

PRIZES

The Governor has been invited to present the prizes during a special awards ceremony at the beach concession area beginning at 2:00p.m. The individual catching the largest fish will receive the "Governor's Trophy" and have their name engraved on the Governor's Cup, which is permanently displayed at Island Beach State Park.

RULES

1. Only the following fish exceeding the minimum length listed below are eligible for entry:

Striped bass-28 in.*	Bluefish-14 in.	
Weakfish-14 in.	Albacore-no min.	
Kingfish-10 in.	Blackfish-14 in.	
Red drum-18 in., not over 27 in.		

Fluke-16 $\frac{1}{2}$ in.

NOTE: *Minimum length for the tournament may differ from NJ saltwater regulations.*

- 2. All fish are measured. Length determines winner, not weight. **NO FISH CAN BE ICED PRIOR TO MEASURING.** In the event of a tie, the first fish entered and measured is the winner.
- 3. Participants are only eligible to win one category.
- 4. Participants must be present to claim any prizes during this event.
- 5. All anglers must sign an affidavit attesting to the authenticity and method of catch prior to entering their catch. A witness is required if the fish is to be measured and released.
- 6. All participants should register their first fish even if it is known that a larger fish has already been caught.

- 7. Fish caught from any boat, surfboard or other floating device will **NOT** be eligible.
- 8. Fish may be caught from any **OCEANSIDE** part of the park from the park entrance to the North Jetty, and the inlet to the dune line. **NO BAYSIDE FISHING OF ANY KIND WILL BE ALLOWED**.
- 9. Terminal tackle will be limited to 2 hooks. A plug counts as 1 hook. Individuals are limited to 2 rods when fishing.
- 10. IGFA guidelines/rules will be applied to the fly fishing category.
- 11. Only one fish per person per species will be eligible for prizes. Anglers may enter fish of more than one species.
- 12. Judges will make a vertical cut in the tail to show the fish has been measured, unless it is immediately released alive.
- 13. All established park regulations apply.
- 14. Please bring sufficient bait.
- 15. No fish measured at the pavilion. All fish must be measured where caught.
- 16. Refer to the current Marine *DIGEST* for saltwater fishing regulations.
