Past Events

Women's Coastal Waterfowl Workshop Sedge Island, NJ | 12/3/21 & 12/4/21

This workshop was a three-week program offered virtually in November to women on coastal waterfowl hunting. Video content and online meetings covered various topics for beginner and intermediate waterfowl hunters. This event

included a mentored waterfowl hunt for ten women at the Division's Sedge Island facility, located just a short boat ride off of Island Beach State Park. The participants learned about blinds, decoys, bird identification, processing their harvest, rules and regulations and more. The workshop concluded with an actual mentored hunt, one in the afternoon and one in the morning, resulting in a wonderful time and great memories!

Women's Intro to Shooting Sports Andover, NJ | 12/4/2021

This event was offered to women ages 18 years and older, who arrived at a beginner level in shooting sports but left with the information and experience they needed to expand their skills. This event was held at the Hudson Farm Club in Andover, NJ. Participants were able to learn about the various types of shooting sports they could participate in.

Women's Intro to Upland Game Workshop Andover, NJ | 12/10/2021 & 12/11/2021

Offered to beginner hunters interested in expanding their participation in the sport, these women learned to identify upland game and what to expect during a typical hunt.
