Green Eggs and Sand is a curriculum around the horseshoe crab. During the workshop participants learn from experts about the biology of the horseshoe crab, their relationship to migrating shorebirds, their importance to humans, and how the species is managed. The curriculum provides video and activity components that can be incorporated into any classroom! This year the workshop will be offered online with virtual meet-ups. New Jersey teachers will be invited to an in-person trip to a horseshoe crab spawning beach. Delaware teachers will be invited to a two-day in person workshop, including a trip to a horseshoe crab spawning beach.

Part 1—Green Eggs and Sand—Virtual

Open to <u>ALL</u> educators. By attending this virtual workshop, you will receive access to the Green Eggs and Sand curriculum plus other education materials. The curriculum is broken down into four modules, and content for each module will be presented over the course of five weeks (three videos to watch weekly) in conjunction with online meet-ups. Meet-up dates are listed below and will provide an opportunity for a questions and answers session with the expert presenter for each module. All virtual meet-ups will be from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.
