Warm, Cool and Coldwater Fish Raised at and Stocked from the Hackettstown Hatchery in 2015

A total of 3,060,206 fish weighing a total of 23,459 pounds were raised at the Charles O. Hayford Hatchery by the NJ Division of Fish and Wildlife in 2015. Fish are raised and stocked for the angling enjoyment of the public and paid for through license fees and Sportfish Restoration funds. Species included: Northern Pike, Muskellunge, Tiger Muskie, Walleye, Striped Bass Hybrid, Atlantic Salmon, Channel Catfish, Largemouth Bass, Smallmouth Bass, Brown Bullhead, Bluegill Sunfish, Golden Shiner, Fathead Minnows and Gambusia (Mosquito Fish).
