The Women's Coastal Waterfowl Virtual Workshop is part of the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife's "Outdoor Women of New Jersey" (O.W.N.J.) program. O.W.N.J. workshops are designed to provide **women 18 years of age or older** with a welcoming environment in which to learn outdoor skills. These workshops are for newcomers and experienced outdoors women, outdoor enthusiasts who wants to learn new skills, or someone who wishes to network with others.

<u>Workshop Overview</u>: This workshop will take place over three weeks with each week focusing on a different aspect of coastal waterfowl hunting. Video content will be paired with online meetings that will cover topics including, history of waterfowl hunting; waterfowl biology and identification; hunting regulations, equipment, and techniques; and more! The weekly meetups will discuss the week's content, allow for you to ask questions, and get to hear from experienced waterfowl hunters.
