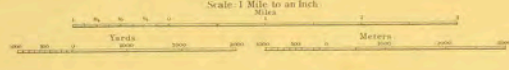


A TOPOGRAPHICAL MAP OF KITTATINNY VALLEY AND MOUNTAIN
