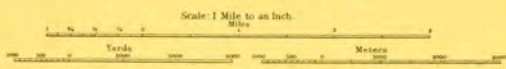


A TOPOGRAPHICAL MAP OF KITATINNY VALLEY AND MOUNTAIN

Surveys made in 1884. Railroads revised to date.

NOTE: The contour lines are level lines drawn on the earth's surface. All points through which any given line passes are at the same level and their height above mean sea level is shown by the figures on the line. The rise or fall from any line to the next is as the figures will show. Small figures set on any line show the actual elevation of the surface at a point indicated by a small cross.
