NOTE. The curved lines are level lines drawn on the earth's surface. All points through which any given line passes are at the same level and their height above mean sea level is shown by the figures on the line. The row of figures next to any line in the figures will show 2500 feet. Figures not on any line show the actual elevation of the surface at a point indicated by a small cross.
