NOTE: The curved lines are level lines drawn on the earth's surface. All points through which they pass are shown at the same level and their height above mean sea level is shown by the figures on the line. The rise or fall from any one level to the next is as the figures will show. Dotted figures and an arrow line show the actual direction of the surface at a point indicated by a small cross.
