All points through which any given line passes are at the same level and their height above mean sea level is shown by the figures on the line. The true or fall from any line to the north is on the figure will show 20 feet in the northeast and 10 feet in the southeast position. Figures not on any line show the actual elevation of the surface at a point indicated by a small cross.
