

Guidelines for Group Hiking & Camping in Worthington State Forest

- ◇ Camping along the A.T. is first come first serve and Appalachian Trail Conservancy guidelines for groups apply.
- ◇ Camping and hiking in groups of more than 10 people is not permitted on the Appalachian Trail.
- ◇ Primitive backpack camping is permitted while hiking along the Appalachian Trail. Hikers may not stay more than one night at any location.
- ◇ In Worthington State Forest there is an established Backpacker Campsite located at the intersection of the Douglas Trail and Appalachian Trail.
- ◇ Camping on the AT is prohibited except at the Backpacker Campsite while in Worthington State Forest.
- ◇ No ground fires are permitted.
- ◇ Group leaders should have a roster of their members.
