







USGS Topographic Maps

In 2017, the New Jersey Pinelands Commission passed a resolution that adopted **USGS Topographic Maps** which labeled 510 miles of routes within Wharton State Forest.

Further review by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection determined that **120 miles of routes** were not routes at all, they were:

- boundary lines
- hiking trails
- nonexistent

- fire control lines
- inaccessible

These misidentified routes are shown as brown-dashed lines on the USGS Topographic Map.

The remaining 390 miles of routes considered for vehicle use are shown as solid brown lines.
