How to Interpret the New Jersey Regulations

The New Jersey regulations incorporate by reference the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) regulations. For Subchapters 50-64, in order to determine compliance, you must examine the incorporated New Jersey Subchapters as well as the NRC's regulations. For your convenience, links to the NRC regulations have been placed in the New Jersey regulations. With the exception of Subchapter 6, the New Jersey incorporations are generally set up as follows:

- (a) Specifies which Part of the NRC regulations is being incorporated
- (b) Specifies which provisions of the NRC regulations are NOT being incorporated
- (c) Specifies which provisions of the NRC regulations are being incorporated with CHANGES.

On this website, all the NRC provisions of 10 CFR 20 have been inserted into Subchapter 6 so that it is not necessary to consult the NRC regulations.
