1. Call to Order and Introduction:

Ms. Dixon called the meeting of the Board to order at 9:41 a.m. Ms. Dixon announced that notice of the meeting was provided to the Secretary of State, designated personnel in the DEP and three newspapers. Additionally, a notice of this meeting was sent to all radiologic technology educational programs and individuals having business at this

meeting and was published on the Radiation Protection Element's website. Ms. Dixon also outlined the format for public discussion and comments.

4. Credentials Committee Report

Mr. Robinson reported that after the tabled Credentials discussion on September 12, 2024, the Bureau was provided with legal guidance on the matter of the 22 individuals involved in the DANB investigation. Charging documents were drafted for the 22 individuals who were listed on August 9, 2024, DANB notice of Disciplinary Action.

Mr. Robinson made the Board aware that the documents were issued (i.e. cover letter and charging document) to the individuals, via standard mail, certified mail and e-mail, letting them know of the action that will be discussed regarding their licensure and allowed them time to respond and provided the link to the meeting.

Therefore, the committee's prior recommendation to the Board stands. The Board voted (4 Yea, 1 No, and 0 Abstentions) approving the filing of the charges against the licensee (Charging document). The members additionally, voted unanimously (5 Yea, 0 No, 0 Abstentions) to bring forward the Charges to the Commission on Radiation Protection for a recommendation regarding N.J.S.A. 34a and N.J.A.C. 7:28-19.5 (a)3 on the licenses of Angie Paola Matta, Erika Maldonado, Evy Mayte Cruze Castillo, Gabrielly Christina Binatti Fortunato, Gypsy Pomarica, Issac DeSantana, Izayana Mendoza, Joselyne Zhinin-Arguello, Josiah Rios, Kariston Da Silva, Katherin Cortazar, Kayla Soto, Kelly Dos Reis, Kimberly Milliorelli Chaves, Raquel Seebach, Rayanne Araujo, Raydiry Valerio-Peralta, Sacha Carreras De Paulino, Sade Privado, Sasha Cordeiro, Sthefany Novillo Almache, and S'waya Hawley.

After the Board voted on the charging document and to pass the recommendation to CORP, a Board member requested to make a secondary motion. That motion was as follows: considering the required 2-year waiting time before applying for restoration of a revoked license, the Board recommends to CORP that all options be considered for persons guilty of fraud or deceit in procuring a license, including censure, reprimand, suspension for a fixed period or otherwise disciplined. The vote was unanimously (5 Yea, 0 No and 0 Abstentions).


