The Hudson County Plaza public parking area is located adjacent to the Hudson County Plaza building which contains the offices of the County Clerk, County Registra, Board of Elections. Voter registration, Passport Office, Family Services Offices and other public service departments. Hundreds of cars a day utilize the parking facilities conducting business that can take a quarter of an hour to multiple hours.

The parking lot is located just three blocks from the Eastbound Intersate 78 exit (last exit before the NJ Turnpike terminus at the Holland Tunnel) and the Westbound entrance. The public parking is located within a short walk to the McGinley Square Special Improvement District and the Jackson Hill Main Street commercial corridor, both of which offer a host of fast food and cafe style restaurants, shopping and food markets for the local and long distance traveler. It is also walking distance to Hudson County High Tech, Saint Peter's University and the Jersey City Armory, all hosting sites for regional events and activities. And several hundred newly rehabilitated and rebuilt public housing residences are within blocks of the site as well.
